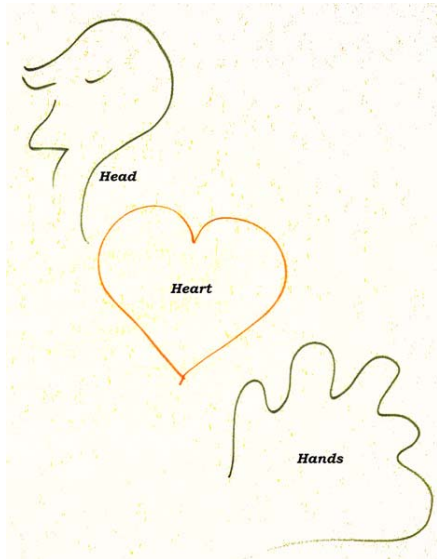


Resources and Training Materials
